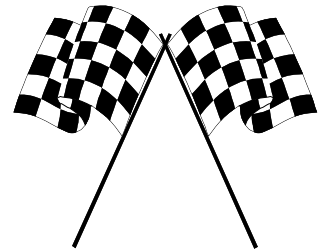

EXHIBITOR'S GATE ADMISSION POLICY

The following regulations will be strictly adhered to:

All competitors (drivers & pit crew) are required to have a gate pass, which may be ordered when filling out your entry form. Gate Admission is \$10.00.

- All vehicles must be ready for inspections upon arrival at the assembly pit area. There shall be no alterations of any kind performed in the assembly pit area unless requested by the officials.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(For Car Division & Ladies Only Class)

1. All drivers must complete a valid entry and release waiver.
2. Drivers must be a minimum of **18 years of age**.
3. **Drivers must have a valid Driver's Licence. A copy of your valid driver's licence and picture ID must be included with your Entry Form.**
4. All drivers must attend a driver's meeting prior to the beginning of the Derby at **2:00 PM in the Exhibition Center East Hall.**
5. Cars final schedule will be provided at the Driver's meeting.
6. Maximum of only 1 driver and 3-pit crew will be allowed in the pit area. **NO CHILDREN ALLOWED.**
7. All vehicles are required to be in assembly pit area between 7:00 AM and 10:00 AM August 7, 2010.
8. The officials will inspect all vehicles prior to event.
9. Ladies Only Class: Ladies are recommended to have their own car and must comply with Rules & Regulations. Can use a car that is already entered, but must be ready when class is scheduled.
10. **NO ALCOHOL IN THE PIT AREA OR GROUNDS.**
 - A. Drivers or pit crew partaking in or under the influence or found consuming alcohol or drugs onsite will be disqualified immediately.
 - B. The committee reserves the right to implement a Breathalyser test to all or a random selection of participants.
 - C. If found under the influence of alcohol or drugs you will be disqualified as per 10A.
11. All drivers must wear lap & shoulder belts and crash helmets.
 - A. All drivers must wear long sleeve shirts, long pants or non greasy coveralls.
11. **No vehicles in competition are allowed to be driven to or on the grounds except in designated pit and racetrack areas. Must be transported on trailer or by tow truck.**
12. All vehicles must be removed immediately after the event.

RULES AND REGULATIONS (cont'd)

(For Car Division & Ladies Only Class)

Automobile Body Regulations

1. **NORTH AMERICAN MANUFACTURERS** - 1960 or newer, No Chrysler Imperials, Ambulances, Convertibles, Hearses or T-Tops allowed.
2. We are not allowing any white vehicles. Body of vehicles must be color other than white. Only driver's door should be white. The passenger's door must also refrain from being white.
3. **MINIMUM** wheel base of 100".
4. Car tires to be used. P235 X 15" Maximum. Not grips, no studs, no wheel weights, no bias ply, no LT tires, front or rear. Smoother tires are allowed at the discretion of the tech inspectors.
FLYING DEBRI AND ROCKS ARE THE SAFETY ISSUE HERE.

Interior

5. Driver's side of car must have a lap safety belt and one shoulder belt (useable).
6. Remove all upholstery except the front seat.
7. All flammable material must be removed from the interior of the car with the exception of the driver's seat.
8. All holes in fire walls must be filled, covered with metal or non-flammable material.
9. Doors must be chained, welded or bolted. C Channel may be used on both front doors and supported across the width of the vehicle. C Channel may be no greater than 8" in height and 2" in width, extending only 8" beyond the front and back of the front doors with the ends bevelled, no grader blades allowed, may use pipe.
10. A cross brace can be used behind the drivers seat that is connected to the door bars. Cross bar must be within a reasonable size, minimum 3" maximum 6", no dash bars allowed.

Exterior

11. One post behind the driver's seat that is bolted to the roof and floorboard will be allowed for roll over protection, bar cannot be connected to cross brace behind seat. All cars must have a **BLACK** number painted on the driver's door.
12. **All GLASS MUST BE REMOVED!!** It is the driver's option to leave the front windshield in place.
13. All loose equipment must be removed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(For Car Division & Ladies Only Class)

Exterior

14. All chrome, mouldings and lights must be removed, except for front and rear bumpers. Wheel wells may be trimmed.
15. All trailer hitches must be removed.
16. To help prevent hook-ups, bumpers can be cut, leaving no sharp edges. Push shocks may be welded.
17. Bumpers may be chained but not to the frame of the car.
18. Hood must be chained or bolted but not to the undercarriage or the frame.
BOLTED: 4 Places ONLY Options: Radiator support, fender or wheel well.
CHAINED: 4 Places ONLY Use the same options as for Bolted. One wrap of chain, **3/8" MAX.**
19. Hood must have a 12" hole for fire extinguishing purposes.
20. Doors and trunk must also be secured by any of these methods and must be visible from driver's compartment if welded. Weld no longer than 5" long, skip 5", weld 5".
21. Stock gas tank must be removed and another type relocated behind the driver's seat, covered and secured. (Preferably a boat tank or similar quality) Maximum of 5 gallons. No Jerry cans allowed.
- 22. NO PRE-BENDING OF THE CAR BODY OR NOTCHING OF THE FRAME WILL BE TOLERATED!**
23. Brakes must be in working order at the beginning of each heat.
24. EXHAUST - Do not remove the head pipes. Muffler and tailpipes must be removed. Headers through the hood are accepted.

Engine Compartment

25. All air conditioning units, must be discharged and disconnected.
26. Radiator must remain in stock position.
27. Battery must be relocated on the floor on the front passenger side of the car. It must be secured and must be in spill proof box. **MAXIMUM OF 2 BATTERIES PER CAR.**
28. No modified cooling systems.
29. Engine must match make of vehicle.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

(For Car Division & Ladies Only Class)

Rules

30. Driver and three people for pit passes.
31. Each pit **must have** *at least one fire extinguisher.*
32. *No headsets or stopwatches are allowed in cars.*
33. No welding on frame or reinforcements when repairing damaged cars.
34. A maximum of two fires per heat are allowed. A third fire will result in disqualification.
35. In the event of cars getting locked together, only the last 2 cars in a heat will be pulled apart to determine a winner.
36. **Judges decisions are final !!!!** Any appeals or disputes will be handled by the judges.

******Please Note******

These rules were designed for fair play, sporting, no advantages or disadvantages to first time drivers or veterans. If it is not in the rules, DO NOT DO IT!!!!
