GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL FEES INCLUDE 5% G.S.T.

General rules, which are applicable, will govern each department. All department or class rules appearing throughout this premium list take precedence over general rules.

In all cases the right is reserved to reject entirely, or accept conditionally, any entry or application.

Under no circumstances will exhibits, which are offensive (by reason of odor and/or appearances), or those that are dangerous (by reason of their combustion or explosive character) be permitted. If any such exhibit is introduced, by an exhibitor through misrepresentation or otherwise, they may be removed by order of Directors.

Interpretation of all rules is to be made by the Directors of the Association.

No claim for injury to any person shall ever be asserted, nor suit instituted or maintained against the Association, it's officer's or their agents by or on behalf of any visitors or any person, firm or corporation, or their agents, representatives, servants or employees, having license or privilege to exhibit on the fair grounds, or occupying any space thereon. If any damage, loss or injury to person or property shall be proximately caused by reason of neglect or willful act of any person, firm or corporation, their agents, representatives, servants or employees, having license or privilege to exhibit on the fair grounds, or occupying any space thereon, the Association shall in no manner be responsible therefore, and in case it be subject to any expense or liability, all persons causing the same, or liable therefore, shall indemnify the said Association.

- **1.** An exhibitor by making an entry, by doing so agrees to the rules and regulations printed here on, or afterwards to be made by Directors for the government of the exhibition.
- 2. One entry form per exhibitor. Separate entry must be made for each article. Required fees must accompany all entries. Please use appropriate entry forms for each section. DO NOT USE BACK OF ENTRY FORM.
- **3. Retain claim check at bottom of tag** to claim your articles and prize money. Prize money is available during fair week at the voucher bank located in the exhibition office; hours are 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. daily.
- **4.** Exhibits, which have been incorrectly entered, may, at the discretion of the judge or committee in charge, be transferred to proper classes previous to the judging. If such classes have been judged, they shall not be re-judged.
- **6. Exhibits competing for prizes** must be the work of the Exhibitor. No entry previously exhibited or awarded a prize at the Prince Albert Exhibition will be accepted.
- Exhibits are to be brought to the Exhibition Centre during the following times:
 <u>Photography:</u> THURSDAY, July 25^h, 11:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m. (Late entries accepted until 4:00 p.m. only).
 .*<u>Horticulture</u>: TUESDAY, July 30th, 5:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m. or THURSDAY, Aug. 1st,
 - .^<u>Horticulture</u>: TUESDAY, July 30°°, 5:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m. or THURSDAY, Aug. 1°°, 7:30 a.m. -10:30 a.m.
- **8. Judging** will be done prior to the fair opening. Judges are instructed not to award premiums unless the articles are deemed worthy of merit, or those incorrectly named or listed. All articles soiled, aged, or defaced by wear are not eligible for competition. Sets (i.e. baby sets, doilies, collections) must be securely attached together to avoid any loss. No interface with the judges, officers, or helpers in the discharge of their duties will be permitted.
- **9. All exhibits must remain on display for the entire Exhibition.** Ag & Horticulture & Photography exhibits released 6:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 3rd. All other Exhibits will be released 8:00 p.m. 9:00 p.m. Saturday, August 3rd. Exhibits not picked up at that time will be available for pick-up on the next regular working day at the Exhibition office. Articles will not be released without a claim check.
- 10.Security service is provided for exhibits during Exhibition Week. Every precaution in care and handling of entries will be taken, BUT NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE ASSUMED FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE.
- **11.**Articles not picked up after 30 days will be disposed of unless prior arrangements have been made. Decision of the respective committee is final.
- 12.**Protests** must be made in handwriting and specifically state the cause of the complaint. Protests must be issued to the appropriate Committee, Box 1538, Prince Albert, SK. S6V 5T1, before the last day of the Exhibition.

Please read all rules and regulations to avoid disqualification.


PHOTOGRAPHY

- 1. Youth entries no charge. Amateur entry Fee \$3.50. Advanced \$5.00 and an additional \$1.00 will be added to all late entries.
- 2. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE THE ORIGINAL WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR.
- 3. Prints need to meet the requirements in your category and must be securely attached to 16" x 20" Foam Core or rigid matboard (15" x 20" allowed) or up to 16" x 24" for Advanced. (*Bristol board, cardboard, or framing is not allowed*).
- 4. No wording and or titles to be on exhibit.
- 5. Tags are to be attached to upper right hand corner.
- 6. Exhibitors may enter either the Amateur or Advanced, but not both.
- 7. A photograph may be only entered once. It cannot be re-entered in following years.
- 8. An exhibitor will be limited to only two awards per class.
- 9. The Committee reserves the right to remove entries not meeting criteria and/or not suitable for family viewing. The Committee's decision is final.
- 10. The Director and the Committee have the authority to rule on any issue not specifically covered in these rules.
- 11. Criteria for Judging entries not meeting the rules will not qualify for judging.

STEP 2. Secure matted photo to the foam core, be sure to tape the matting and not the photo to the foam core. This is just one-way to mat and display your photos.
