RULES AND REGULATIONS

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

1. To select the North East judging team to attend the 4-H judging seminar at the Provincial judging competition.
2. To increase the judging skills of 4-H members and encourage leaders' / parents' participation in this event.

GENERAL RULES

1. Participants are expected to attend all events in the program for the duration and are not allowed to care for live stock or attend outside functions during the competition.
2. Any participant caught working together or seeking/receiving coaching during the competition will be disqualified. This does not include questions to the judge.
3. Possession or use of non-prescription drugs and or alcohol is not permitted. Participants using such will be disqualified.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants must be registered 4-H members in the Saskatchewan 4-H program during the year of competition.
2. Participants must be able to write a judging card before the competition, with the exception of Cloverbuds, placing cards will only be required for them.
3. AGE: Cloverbuds: members 6 yrs of age, not more than 8 yrs of age as of Dec. 31, 2019.
Junior - member must be 9 yrs of age, not more than 12 yrs of age as of Dec. 31, 2019.
Intermediate-member must be 13 yrs of age, not more than 14 yrs of age as of Dec. 31, 2019.
Senior - member must be 15 yrs and no older than 21 yrs of age as of Dec. 31, 2019.
International Competitors must be 17 - 21 years of age as of Dec. 31 of the the competition year.
4. All participants must complete and sign the registration/waiver form before they may compete.
5. Participants must pay the entry fee with their registration payable to the "Prince Albert Exhibition Association."

JUDGING

1. Participants will compete in judging any of the following categories:
2. SHEEP, GOATS, LIGHT HORSE, HEAVY HORSE, DAIRY CATTLE, BEEF STEERS, SWINE, BEEF HEIFERS, RABBITS, GRASSES, POULTRY, GRAIN AND MYSTERY CLASS as well as ONE (1) ORAL PRESENTATION. Categories subject to change upon availability of animals. Senior member may be required to provide up to EIGHT (8) oral presentations.
3. Contestants will be asked to judge up to eight (8) classes, providing written reasons for all categories and giving oral reasons for two classes.
4. A total of twenty minutes per class is allotted for the "in the ring" judging.

SCORING

1. The committee's decision is final.
2. Aggregate Award will be based on total scores of the species classes as well as the oral presentations.
3. The committee will break ties. In the case of a tie in the aggregate, the higher standing will be given to the higher score of 2 oral classes combined.

PRIZES

Certificates will be awarded to the top three (3) placing, in each age division.

Clipboards & Pens will be provided.
