RV CAMPING Camping can be booked through Assist Expo at the same time as you make your entries (\$25.00/night plus GST = \$26.25) or call PAEX Office - 306-960-1743 to book a site. You will given a site number. Please do not park in a different site. You will receive a confirmation of your booking within 48 hours. If you have any issues please contact the office.

PARKING If you have booked a stall, enter the grounds at the East entrance off 10th Avenue East, (first entrance near back of Rona) follow the dirt road, past the Main building and park behind the last barn in the row (Barn 1).

If you are only showing for the day enter grounds at the north entrance on 8th Avenue East off 7th Street East, follow road along North Ring, turn right and enter grass area near Brown show office.

Exhibitors show packages will be at the gate you are entering. If you have only entered the Light Horse show the stall will be in Barn 4. 4H Clubs will be assigned to Barn 1. Name of Exhibitor will be put on stall door, shavings bags will be left outside stalls.

PA EX Light Horse Show Rules

Entries MUST Be Received by Friday, August 1/2025!!

Stalls will be available 4:00pm Tuesday, August 5/2025

PLEASE REVIEW ALL RULES

1) Participants are requested to read carefully all rules governing this show. Competition rules will follow the Saskatchewan Horse Federation Rule book. Rules can be found on the Saskatchewan Horse Federation website www.saskhorse.ca. Please be aware of any changes to the SHF rules.

2) SHF Membership is REQUIRED TO SHOW

- 3) Heritage approved classes will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals you must have attended a minimum of two Heritage Circuit shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible to participate in any class within that division.
- 4) Riders must compete in their Age Division, or Open Classes if they choose, as determined by the Year of Birth as it appears on their Birth Certificate.

Age Division	Year of Birth
Junior C	2013 or Later
Junior B	2010 to 2012
Junior A	2007 to 2009
Senior	2006 or earlier

- 5) Show is open to all breeds of horses registered or un-registered
- 6) Stallions are only to be handled and shown by adults over the age of 18 and must be mannerly or they will be excused by the executive
- 7) No horses shall never be tied to the fence or left unattended
- 8) All horses must be hand walked to and from the arena(s). No riding of horses is permitted outside the arena(s).
- 9) All horses must enter and exit out the south door of the barn and be walked behind the barns to get to the arena(s). No horses allowed on the pavement on the south side of the main ring (between barns and arena)
- 10) Physical abuse of horses, over schooling or use of performance enhancing drugs will NOT BE TOLERATED.
- 11) Prize money: 1st \$20, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$10, 4th \$5
- 12) Stake class payout each class with be placed to 5th with the top 4 horses splitting 100% of the pot. If less then 5 entries the payouts will be adjusted accordingly
- 13) Executive reserve the right to correct any error or make any alterations to the regulations on the prize list
- 14) All numbers must be worn on back of competitor or on both sides of the saddle

- 15) English or Western attire and tack accepted in Showmanship
- 16) Chaps are optional in Western Classes
- 17) All competitors in English must wear an approved helmet with harness during competition and or practice
- 18) All juniors must wear ATSM approved protective headgear in or out of the ring
- 19) When the total number of entries in a Junior class is fewer than three, the executive reserves the right to amalgamate the class with any other class of the same type, and if the total of all juniors is less than six, the class will be combined as an all ages junior class.
- 20) Exhibitors are required to produce the animals in the ring for the purpose of being judged when called upon by the announcer in charge, otherwise their right to any prizes to which they might be entitled to will be forfeited.
- 21) No persons will be permitted in the show ring during the time of judging except for the judge and their assistants, exhibitors and the director in charge of the class being judged.
- 22) Any exhibitor who makes a false entry or who shall attempt to interfere with or influence the judges while in discharge of their duties, or who shall use contemptuous or abusive language to a judge, shall forfeit his/her right to all prizes/points he/she might otherwise be entitled to, and shall be excluded from exhibiting at future PA Exhibition shows.
- 23) Any exhibitor lodging a protest must make it in writing with proof to substantiate protest included, and it must be delivered to the Show Secretary within thirty minutes of the last class of the day, It must also be accompanied with a deposit of \$50.00 cash, which will be forfeited to the PA Exhibition Association if the protest is not sustained, The protest will be reviewed at the first meeting following the show.
- 24) Liability: All exhibitors shall be under the control and direction of the PA Exhibition Association but solely at the risk of said exhibitor. The PA Exhibition Association will not be responsible for damage, injury, loss or theft of or to any exhibit, irrespective of the cause of such damage, injury, loss or theft. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for any loss, injury, or damage done to, administered by or arising from any animal or article exhibited by him/her, for its description as given in the catalogue. This shall indemnify the PA Exhibition Association against all legal or other proceeding in regard thereto.
- 25) One horse can only have one rider excluding Peewee, Jack Benny. The names of the horse and exhibitor must be given for each class. No substitutions.
- 26) Any exhibitor who delays the judging by reason of his failure to produce his animals in the ring when their class is called may, at the discretion of the Holding Ring Attendant, be refused admission to the show ring and may forfeit his right to show such animals for a prize.
- 27) Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials, Volunteers, or Staff on the part of the owner, groom or exhibitor may disqualify a horse from adjudication as decided by the Show Committee.
- 28) Each exhibitor will receive one FREE gate pass and one FREE vehicle pass for vehicle pulling trailer. Please buy additional passes accordingly. If you are camping, you will also receive a FREE vehicle pass for that vehicle.
- 29) Exhibitors cancelling their entries for whatever reasons after the officials closing date shall forfeit their fees. On Certification of disability from a qualified veterinarian being received in the Prince Albert Exhibition office before 6:00pm on the final day of classes, entry fees only shall be returned.
- 30) A veterinarian must clear any horse on the grounds found to be sick or coughing in order for it to stay on the premises. Any costs incurred will be the responsibility of the owner. (Competitors please use discretion when bringing in horses).
- 31) All Junior Horse Classes may be asked to supply proof of age, copy of registration or certificate or veterinarian documents.

- 32) In case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding price awarded to the disqualified animal the other prizes shall be adjusted accordingly.
- 33) No exhibitor shall be permitted to show without a number. Any error made due to an exhibitor wearing a wrong number will cancel points credited to that exhibitor in that class. Numbers must be clearly visible.
- 34) Early or late stalling arrivals must be approved by the committee. Box stall doors must be kept closed. Stallions must be stalled secure in the box stalls or tied with halter & stud collar. Stabling will be allocated by the Light Horse Committee without right of appeal and will be awarded by the first come basis. It may not be possible to accommodate all requests. Stabling fees must accompany entry form. Exhibitors will not move their assigned stalls.
- 35) TACK STALLS WILL BE DESIGNATED IF ENTRIES PERMIT. NO GROOMING OF HORSES IN AISLES. HORSES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN ANY AREA OF THE TRAILER PARK. BARNS MUST BE KEPT CLEAN AT ALL TIMES DURING THE FAIR. STALLS MUST BE LEFT IN CLEAN CONDITION WHEN CLASSES ARE FINISHED.
- 36) All horses entered in the Light Horse Show must be in designated stalls or pay the Grounds Fee of \$10.00/day
- 37) The PAEX Open Light horse show declares itself a "C" designation in regards to the Saskatchewan Horse Federation EIA regulations. A Coggins test is not required.
